FISCAL NOTE

HB 506 – SB 531

March 16, 2017

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes persons relocating to Tennessee to be issued a handgun carry permit without completing the classroom and firing range requirements if, within five years prior to the application, the person had a valid handgun carry permit in another state with substantially similar classroom and firing range requirements.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The Department of Safety is expected to verify which states have substantially similar classroom and firing range requirements within existing resources.
- Any fiscal impact related to the provision of classroom and firing range requirements for handgun carry permit applicants are borne between private parties.
- The provisions of the bill are not expected to significantly impact the number handgun permit schools or the number of handgun carry permits issued or renewed each year.
