FISCAL NOTE

HB 702 - SB 651

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires an agent of the Department of Agriculture (DOA) to remove a food, drug, device, or cosmetic tag or marking, on a detained or embargoed article if such agent fails to petition for an order of condemnation, within 14 days of such detainer or embargo, rather than within 15 days.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- The DOA will ensure compliance for tags requiring removal by an agent within the 14-day time requirement using existing resources without an increased appropriation or a reduced reversion.
