SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Commissioner of the Department of Health (DOH), on or before January 15, 2018, to report to the Health Committee of the House of Representatives and the Health and Welfare Committee of the Senate, on the impact of recent legislation regulating and licensing pain management clinics in reducing the abuse of opioids in Tennessee. The Commissioner is required to make recommendations for any needed legislation to address issues raised by opioid abuse.
