HB 1165 - SB 1222

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Governor to include a description of each construction project occurring on state-owned property within the inventory documents maintained by the Governor pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 12-2-102.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 12-2-102, the Governor is authorized and directed to maintain a complete inventory of all state-owned property, together with necessary surveys, maps, photographs and appraisals. One copy shall be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State; one copy shall be filed with the Commissioner of the Department of General Services; one copy shall be maintained by the Governor; and additional copies may be filed with other public officials as the Governor may designate, so that the same may be made a part of the permanent records of the state.
- The State Building Commission will be able to provide the Governor's Office sufficient descriptions of construction projects occurring on state-owned property within existing resources without an additional appropriation or reduced reversion.
- Including descriptions of construction projects occurring on state-owned property within the inventory documents maintained by the Governor can be accomplished utilizing existing resources without an additional appropriation or reduced reversion.
