HB 1412 - SB 1418

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Tennessee Council for Career and Technical Education (Council) to submit an annual report to the Education Committees of the General Assembly on the amount of funds necessary to accomplish certain federal mandates and the amount of funding reimbursed to the Council for official business.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The Council is administratively attached to the Department of Education (DOE).
- DOE employees will compile and submit the required information to the General Assembly in the normal course of business. Any increase in state expenditures is estimated to be not significant and can be accommodated within existing resources without an increased appropriation or a reduced reversion.
