FISCAL NOTE

HB 2003 – SB 2587

February 5, 2018

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Dyslexia Advisory Council (the Council) to submit its annual report to the House Education Administration and Planning Committee, no later than December 31 of each year.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Under current law, Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-1-229, the Council is currently required to submit its annual report to the Senate Education Committee and the House Education Instructions and Programs Committee.
- Any costs for printing additional copies of the report are estimated to be not significant and can be accommodated utilizing existing resources without an increased appropriation or a reduced reversion.
- The Council will be able to amend its policies in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- No significant impact to local government.
