FISCAL NOTE

HB 2014 - SB 1992

SUMMARY OF BILL: Permits a licensed attorney acting on behalf of an employee of the Department of Correction (DOC) to inspect the investigative records and reports of the Internal Affairs Division of the DOC prior to a due process hearing on a disciplinary action against the employee.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFIANT

Assumptions:

- Tennessee Code Annotated § 10-7-504 permits an employee of the DOC to inspect their records and reports of the Internal Affairs Division of the DOC prior to a due process hearing on a disciplinary action against the employee.
- The proposed legislation permits an attorney acting on behalf of the DOC employee to inspect the records prior to a due process hearing on a disciplinary action against the employee unless the inspection of such records is denied by the Commissioner of the DOC.
- The proposed legislation will not significantly impact the current policies or operations of the DOC.
