FISCAL NOTE

HB 2065 - SB 2023

February 26, 2018

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes a person who is deaf or hard of hearing and who possesses a motor vehicle registration to request notation be made in the Tennessee crime information center (TCIC) database to assist law enforcement in identifying the operator of a vehicle registered in such person's name as possibly being deaf or hard of hearing.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Based on information provided by the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation, this information will not get added to the TCIC, but to the motor vehicle registration database within the Department of Revenue (DOR). Law enforcement officers will have access to this information when a vehicle's registration status is checked.
- The DOR can implement the provisions of this legislation utilizing existing resources.
- The Department of Safety and the Motor Vehicle Commission (MVC) will adopt new policies and procedures to effectuate the legislation without an increased appropriation or reduced reversion.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-29-121, all regulatory boards are required to be self-supporting over any two- year period. The Motor Vehicle Commission experienced a deficit of \$265,344 in FY15-16, a surplus of \$221,695 in FY16-17, and had a cumulative reserve balance of \$2,196,368 on June 30, 2017.
