**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 2070 – SB 2020**

February 16, 2018

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Decreases, from 60 to 30 days, the time in which a utilization review agent has to notify contracted health care providers of a change in preauthorization requirements that impact health care resources and services for cancer patients.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

Assumption:

- Based on information provided by the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the proposed legislation will not impact any existing programs or policies; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

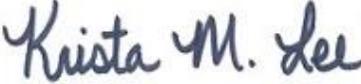
Assumption:
