SUMMARY OF BILL: Designates the fourth Saturday of July each year as “Tennessee Day of Cowboy” to honor American cowboys and cowboy culture.

- The fourth Saturday of July shall not be a legal holiday as defined in Tenn. Code Ann. § 15-1-101. Therefore, the fiscal impact to state or local government is estimated to be not significant.
