FISCAL NOTE

HB 2362 - SB 2425

February 16, 2018

SUMMARY OF BILL: Deletes the requirement that votes on a metropolitan planning organization's (MPO) policy board be equally weighted.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Under current law, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 64-8-301, an MPO policy board is required to ensure that the votes of local government officials on the board are equally weighted and are not based on the population of the area represented by each official.
- The proposed language would delete the requirement that votes be equally weighted and authorize member votes to be weighted based on the population of the area the official represented.
- The proposed language is only applicable to the Nashville MPO transportation policy board, which provides policy direction regarding transportation and air quality decisions. Any fiscal impact to state and local government is estimated to be not significant.
