**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 2513 - SB 2546**

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) to review the number of expunction petitions filed in 2018 for crimes committed prior to November 1, 1983, and report to the General Assembly in January 2020.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation requires the TBI, beginning January 1, 2019, to review the number of expunction petitions filed in 2018 for crimes committed prior to November 1, 1983, and the number of those petitions granted and the number rejected. The TBI must report to the General Assembly in January 2020.
- The TBI can conduct the study within its existing resources. The proposed legislation will not significantly impact TBI's operations.
