SUMMARY OF BILL: Deletes obsolete statute which required the Commissioner of the Department of Commerce and Insurance (TDCI) to study and identify any impediments within state law which deter insurance companies from underwriting policies of insurance for persons who have used justified deadly force. The results of the study were required to be reported to the General Assembly no later than March 1, 2012.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Removing an obsolete statute which required the TDCI to conduct a study and report to the General Assembly no later than March 1, 2012, will not result in any significant fiscal impact.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Removing an obsolete study requirement will have no significant impact on businesses in this state.
