SB 358 - HB 711

February 22, 2017

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes a respondent to an ex parte order of protection to waive the right to a hearing within 15 days if the respondent acknowledges that the order shall remain in effect until the hearing is held and the court finds that the interests of justice require the continuance of the hearing.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation will not result in additional ex parte orders of protection being issued, but delays the required hearing after issuance of an ex parte order.
- The Administrative Office of the Courts reports that the proposed legislation will not significantly impact the courts' operations and that any impact can be accommodated within existing resources.
