**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 442 - HB 732**

February 17, 2017

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Adds to the list of confidential records, video taken by a law enforcement body camera that depicts interactions with minors, the interior of a healthcare or mental health facility, or the interior of a private residence where no crime has occurred.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Managing such records, including images and audio, in a confidential manner is not anticipated to increase expenditures for state or local law enforcement agencies.
- The provisions of the bill will not alter the current procedures related to capturing, storage, or discarding of any such records.
- The Department of Safety does not use police body cameras; therefore, the fiscal impact on the department will be not significant.
- The Office of the Attorney General, the Administrative Office of the Courts, and the Public Defenders Conference all report the bill will have no impact on departmental operations.
