FISCAL NOTE

SB 467 - HB 560

February 16, 2017

SUMMARY OF BILL: Creates a new Class A misdemeanor, punishable by a \$2,000 fine, for the intentional unauthorized release of a law enforcement officer's residential address and a Class B misdemeanor, punishable by a \$500 fine, for the negligent unauthorized release of a law enforcement officer's residential address.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 10-7-504(f)(1)(D), the residential street address of any public employee is required to be treated as confidential and not be open for inspection by members of the public.
- There will not be a sufficient number of prosecutions for state or local government to experience any significant increase in revenue or expenditures.
- It is assumed that the courts and district attorneys can accommodate any impact within their existing resources.
- The Administrative Office of the Courts confirms that they can accommodate any impact within their existing resources.
