SB 659 - HB 797

March 11, 2017

SUMMARY OF BILL: Decreases, from 30 to 10 days, the length of time a municipal corporation must wait before enforcing or ceasing to enforce traffic ordinances on the campus of a state higher education institution within its borders after receiving a request from the institution.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Decreasing the time frame for a municipal corporation to enforce or cease to enforce traffic ordinances on a campus or state institution requested from an institution will not result in a significant increase in traffic citations. Any fiscal impact on state or local government revenue or expenditures is estimated to be not significant.
