SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Attorney General and Reporter to conduct an investigation of any complaint filed under the General Assembly Workplace Discrimination and Harassment Policy. The Attorney General's investigation report shall be subject to public disclosure with all identifying information of the complainant, accused, or any witness being redacted.
