FISCAL NOTE

SB 2054 - HB 2141

February 14, 2018

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires elected constables to complete 40 hours of in-service every 12 months in office.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Under current law, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 8-10-202, constables are required to complete 40 hours of in-service within 12 months being elected.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 8-10-201, constables are responsible for paying costs associated with in-service courses unless state or local funds are made available.
- In-service courses are provided by a private entity.
- Any increase in cost associated with attending additional in-service hours not included in state or local budgets will be paid by constables.
- Any impact to state or local government is estimated to be not significant.
