SB 2104 - HB 2229

SUMMARY OF BILL: Defines “homemade food or drink product” for purposes of the Tennessee Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act, title 53, chapter 1, part 1. Provides that homemade food and drink products are not subject to licensure, inspection, or labeling requirements if made in a private home kitchen and sold to an informed end consumer.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- According to the Department of Agriculture and the Department of Health, these food products are currently exempt from licensure and inspection.
- The proposed legislation will not significantly impact the policies and operations of the Department of Health or the Department of Agriculture.
