FISCAL NOTE

SB 2115 - HB 2492

February 21, 2018

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes licensed plant dealers under the Tennessee Plant Pest Act to market and do business under multiple business names with one license as long as the new business' promotional materials designate the relationship with the license holder and the new business shares the same location with the license holder.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation does not impact the issuance or revocation of licenses by the Department of Agriculture; it authorizes a license holder to do business under multiple names at the same location with one license.
- The proposed legislation will not significantly impact the department's policies or operations.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Any impact to commerce or jobs in Tennessee as a result of the proposed legislation is considered not significant.
