**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 2387 - HB 2436**

February 23, 2018

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) to send the results of the criminal background checks of a professional bondsman to the clerks of the courts responsible for regulating the bondsman within 10 business days.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Tennessee Code Annotated § 40-11-317(a) requires that a person who applies to become a professional bondsman submit a criminal background check with the license application.
- The TBI currently conducts these criminal background checks and forwards the results of the background checks to the appropriate county clerks.
- The proposed legislation would require the TBI to forward the criminal background check to the county clerk responsible for regulating the activities of the professional bondsman within 10 business days.
- The proposed legislation will not significantly impact the current policies or operations of the TBI.
