AMEND Senate Bill No. 1751*

House Bill No. 2290

by adding the following as a new subdivision (d)(3) in the amendatory language of Section 1:

(3) Notwithstanding subdivision (d)(1), if the violation occurs in a work zone when employees of the department of transportation or construction workers are present or in a marked school zone when a warning flasher or flashers are in operation, the fine is five hundred dollars (\$500).

AND FURTHER AMEND by redesignating subsection (d) in the amendatory language of Section 2 as subdivision (d)(1) and adding the following as a new subdivision (d)(2):

(2) Notwithstanding subdivision (d)(1), if the violation occurs in a work zone when employees of the department of transportation or construction workers are present or in a marked school zone when a warning flasher or flashers are in operation, the fine is five hundred dollars (\$500).

AND FURTHER AMEND by adding the following as a new Section 3 and renumbering the existing Section 3 accordingly:

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-136(c), is amended by adding the following immediately after the language "Class C misdemeanor":
; provided, that if the violation is the result of the driver's use of a mobile telephone or wireless telecommunications device, the fine is five hundred dollars (\$500)
