

HOUSE BILL 1030

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-38-505 and Section 67-4-602, relative to the statewide automated victim information and notification system fund.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-38-505, is amended by deleting the language "The grant authorized in this section shall not exceed six hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$650,000) and is subject to authorization contained in the general appropriations act." and substituting instead the language "The grant authorized in this section is subject to authorization contained in the general appropriations act."

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-4-602(h)(1), is amended by adding the following language at the end of the subdivision:

Effective July 1, 2019, the privilege tax on litigation imposed by this subdivision (h)(1) is increased in the amount of two dollars (\$2.00), for a total of five dollars (\$5.00), which must be deposited to the statewide automated victim information and notification system fund created by subdivision (h)(2).

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-4-602(h)(2)(B), is amended by deleting the subdivision and substituting instead the following:

Notwithstanding the apportionment of revenue formula in § 67-4-606, proceeds from the privilege tax on litigation imposed by subdivision (h)(1) must be deposited in the statewide automated victim information and notification system fund.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019, the public welfare requiring it.
