WHEREAS, Dr. Glenn is a member of Greater Middle Baptist Church, where he serves as a trustee, Sunday school teacher, and chair of the stewardship ministry; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Howard Glenn is an exemplary individual; his commitment to excellence and community service is representative of the Volunteer State, and he should be specially recognized; now, therefore,
