

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 720

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Marcie Rudd of Jackson to the State Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-2201, provides for the creation of the State Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-2201(a)(1)(D)(i), provides that three (3) members of the commission shall be citizens of this state who are not employed in the public kindergarten through grade twelve (K-12) educational system but who are knowledgeable of education issues in this state; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-2201(a)(1)(D)(ii)(a), provides that the governor shall appoint a person who resides in the western grand division of the state; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Lee, acting pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-2201(a)(1)(D)(ii)(a), has appointed Marcie Rudd of Jackson as a member of the State Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission for a term that will expire on June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Marcie Rudd has previously taught in both public and private schools; she holds a Bachelor of Arts in Elementary Education from Harding University; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-2201(b)(1), provides that each appointed member shall be confirmed by joint resolution of the General Assembly; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED ELEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE

CONCURRING, that we hereby confirm the appointment of Marcie Rudd to the State Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission for a term that will expire on June 30, 2022.
