

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 821

A RESOLUTION relative to illegal firearm discharges in  
Tennessee.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED  
ELEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE  
CONCURRING, that all U.S. Attorneys serving in Tennessee are urged and encouraged to  
pursue criminal charges against persons discharging firearms in violation of state or federal  
laws on the interstate system and other federal highways in Tennessee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the department of transportation is urged and  
encouraged to utilize the appropriate technology, or make such technology available to local law  
enforcement agencies, to stop or prevent illegal firearm discharges, including the use of  
audio/video equipment that pinpoints the locations from which such discharges occur or have  
occurred in areas in which gang-related violence is prevalent.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution be transmitted to  
each U.S. Attorney serving in Tennessee and to the Commissioner of Transportation.
