WHEREAS, no stranger to awards and accolades, he was honored as one of the Top 40 Under 40 by the *Memphis Business Journal* in 2013; and

WHEREAS, Nick Kistenmacher is wholly committed to the noble precepts of public service that have earned Tennessee recognition as the Volunteer State, and he should be specially recognized; now, therefore,
