A RESOLUTION to denounce the use of taxpayer money to maintain symbols of racism, repression, or hatred.

WHEREAS, in 1987, this State prohibited investing State funds in the Republic of South Africa, a country that denied fundamental civil rights to its citizens and permanent residents; and

WHEREAS, this State presently uses taxpayer funds to maintain monuments that promote racism, repression, or hatred in the State of Tennessee; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED ELEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, that we denounce the use of taxpayer money to maintain monuments that symbolize racism, repression, or hatred.
