

SENATE BILL 1492

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55,
relative to airbags and similar restraint system
components.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. The department of safety is requested to conduct a study on the number of motor vehicle accidents reported to the department during the previous four (4) calendar years that resulted in serious bodily injury or property damage exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000) and involved a malfunctioning airbag or other restraint system component. If any such study is conducted, the department shall submit its findings and any recommendations on or before February 1, 2020, to the transportation and safety committee of the senate and the transportation committee of the house of representatives.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
