

SENATE BILL 2427

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 1, Part 3 and Title 4, Chapter 1, Part 4, relative to Tennessee's first people.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 1, Part 4, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

The following cultural groups are recognized as Tennessee's first peoples:

- (1) The Algonquin peoples, including the Shawnee and Lenape;
- (2) The Chickamaugan peoples;
- (3) The Iroquoian peoples, including the Cherokee;
- (4) The Muskogean peoples, including the Alabama, Coosa, Chickasaw, Natchez, Koasati, Tuskegee, and Taliwa;
- (5) The Siouan peoples, including the Quapaw and Mosepelia; and
- (6) The Yuchean peoples, including the Chisca, Yuchi, Taougalé, Tongeria, and Tamahita.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
