

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 603

A RESOLUTION to honor and commend Rear Admiral Terry Moulton upon his induction into the REdl Hall of Fame.

WHEREAS, it is fitting that the members of this General Assembly should salute those citizens who, through their extraordinary efforts, have distinguished themselves as community leaders of whom we can all be proud; and

WHEREAS, one such noteworthy person is Rear Admiral Terry Moulton, who will be inducted into the REdl Hall of Fame as a member of its inaugural class in a special ceremony to be held at the Paradise Ranch and Event Center in Springfield on May 7, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the REdl Hall of Fame, an initiative of the REdl Education Foundation, celebrates the accomplishments of those who have graduated from Robertson County public schools and impacted the world far beyond the reaches of their hometown, thus showing current students that there is no limit to what they can achieve; and

WHEREAS, the REdl Education Foundation strives to have a positive impact on the educational culture in Robertson County by giving exceptional support to local schools and providing investments of time and money; and

WHEREAS, a member of the Greenbrier High School Class of 1978, Rear Admiral Moulton serves as the U.S. Navy Deputy Surgeon General and Deputy Chief of the U.S. Navy Bureau of Medicine and Surgery, positions he has held since December 17, 2015; and

WHEREAS, at sea, Rear Admiral Terry Moulton served on USS *Nimitz* (CVN 68) for a six-month deployment to the Persian Gulf in support of Operation Desert Storm; ashore, his assignments have included the Naval Hospital in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; the Naval Medical Clinic at Pearl Harbor, Hawaii; the Naval Air Station at Barbers Point, Hawaii, where he served

as clinic director; the U.S. Naval Hospital in Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, where he served as director for administration; the Naval Hospital in Cherry Point, North Carolina; and the Naval Hospital in Pensacola, Florida, where he served as the executive officer; and

WHEREAS, Rear Admiral Moulton has served as commanding officer of Fleet Hospital Pensacola, U.S. Naval Hospital Okinawa, and Naval Medical Center Portsmouth; he has also served as commander of Navy Medicine East and director of the Enhanced Tidewater Multi-Service Market Office; and

WHEREAS, the members of this General Assembly find it appropriate to acknowledge and applaud Rear Admiral Terry Moulton for his dedication to the State of Tennessee and its citizens; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED ELEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that we honor and commend Rear Admiral Terry Moulton upon his induction into the REdl Hall of Fame and extend to him our best wishes for continued success in his future endeavors.
