

SENATE RESOLUTION 88

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Mark Gill of Nashville to the Tennessee board of regents.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-8-201, provides for the creation of the Tennessee board of regents; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-8-201, further provides that the governor shall appoint twelve members to the Tennessee board of regents; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Lee has appointed Mark Gill of Nashville to the Tennessee board of regents as a member representing Middle Tennessee to a term that will expire on June 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Gill is a retired Tennessee businessman, who was raised on a family farm in the Upper Cumberland, where his family has resided since the Revolutionary War; educated in public schools, he spent more than thirty years in the fields of corporate finance and accounting; and

WHEREAS, building on an interest in and understanding of public policy derived from his years in business, Mr. Gill became active as a citizen in state policy, focusing on issues such as state taxation, education, and workforce development; and

WHEREAS, Mark Gill is a person of integrity and an active citizen whose benevolence, acumen, and strong commitment to public service have helped to enhance the well-being of this State and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-8-201, provides that each member appointed by the governor to the Tennessee board of regents shall be confirmed by the senate; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED ELEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, that this body does hereby confirm the appointment of Mark Gill to the Tennessee board of regents for a term that will expire on June 30, 2024.
