Constitutional Amendments- Proposes amendment to Article VI, Section 5 to provide for the selection of the attorney general and reporter for the state with nomination by the supreme court and confirmation by the general assembly. -

2. [SJR 0003](#) *Niceley

Constitutional Amendments- Proposes additional language in Article II, Section 28 to prohibit the general assembly from levying, authorizing, or otherwise permitting any state tax on property. -

3. [SB 0076](#) *Haile

Public Records- As introduced, authorizes the transfer of wills and marriage licenses from the clerk's office to other suitable facilities. - Amends TCA Title 10, Chapter 7; Title 18, Chapter 1; Section 18-6-109 and Section 32-2-102.

4. [SB 0095](#) *Watson, Crowe (HB 0041 by *Van Huss)

Handgun Permits- As introduced, requires the department of safety to issue a handgun carry permit containing zeros in place of an expiration date upon request by a permit holder or applicant who is in the military and stationed outside this state. - Amends TCA Section 39-17-1351.

5. [SB 0010](#) *Briggs (HB 0002 by *Staples)

Sentencing- As introduced, enacts the "JaJuan Latham Act," which increases the penalty for an aggravated assault or homicide that occurs by a person discharging a firearm from within a motor vehicle and the victim is a minor at the time of the offense. - Amends TCA Title 39, Chapter 13, Part 1 and Title 39, Chapter 13, Part 2.

6. [SB 0011](#) *Briggs (HB 0004 by *Staples)

Children- As introduced, establishes a pilot program for three years to provide child care payments to eligible relative caregivers; requires the department of children's services to publish an annual report containing certain data about the pilot program. - Amends TCA Title 37 and Title 71.

7. [SB 0012](#) *Briggs (HB 0003 by *Staples)

Courts- As introduced, requires a court that issues orders granting custody or guardianship of children to relative caregivers to inform the relative caregiver that resources and funding may be available through the department of children's services; defines "relative caregiver" as person within a first, second, or third degree of relationship to the parent or step-parent of a child who may be related through blood, marriage, or adoption. - Amends TCA Title 16; Title 36 and Title 37.
