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**[HB 0859](#) by \*Thompson (SB 0941 by \*Yarbro)**

Economic and Community Development, Dept. of - As introduced, establishes the office of apprenticeship and work-study programs within the department; provides a tax credit to entities that participate in the programs; and reinstates certain apprenticeship programs for certain professional boards and commissions. - Amends TCA Title 4; Title 49; Title 62 and Title 67.

**[HB 1108](#) by \*Powell, Clemmons (SB 0037 by \*Gilmore, Robinson)**

Professions and Occupations - As introduced, repeals requirements that authorization to engage in regulated professions and occupations be revoked for persons who default on student loans; requires reinstatement of licenses for otherwise qualified applicants whose licenses were suspended, denied, or revoked based solely on defaulting on student loan repayment. - Amends TCA Title 3, Chapter 6, Part 3; Title 23, Chapter 3; Title 38, Chapter 1; Title 49; Title 55; Title 56; Title 62 and Title 63.

**[HB 1472](#) by \*Hardaway (SB 1310 by \*Kyle)**

Business and Commerce - As introduced, enacts certain provisions relative to business or industries undergoing a reduction in operations that negatively impacts employees. - Amends TCA Title 4; Title 5; Title 6; Title 7; Title 9; Title 10; Title 50; Title 64 and Title 67.

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**[HB 0159](#) by \*Sexton C (SB 1465 by \*Bailey)**

Health Care - As introduced, extends the Suicide Prevention Act of 2018 indefinitely; requires the department of health to compile data on the medications that were prescribed to those dying from suicide; requires that a report be made to the health committee of the house of representatives and the health and welfare committee of the senate no later than June 30, 2020, and by June 30 every two years thereafter. - Amends TCA Title 4; Title 5; Title 6; Title 7; Title 33; Title 63; Title 68 and Chapter 1005 of the Public Acts of 2018.

**[HB 1116](#) by \*Coley, Hardaway (SB 0603 by \*Jackson)**

Criminal Offenses - As introduced, increases the punishment for reckless endangerment with a deadly weapon to a Class D felony if the offense occurred during a road rage incident. - Amends TCA Title 39, Chapter 13 and Title 55, Chapter 10, Part 2.

**[HB 0608](#) by \*Curcio, Littleton, Reedy, Griffey (SB 0512 by \*Roberts, Kurita)**

Courts - As introduced, adds an additional trial court in the 23rd judicial district comprised of Cheatham, Dickson, Houston, Humphreys, and Stewart counties effective September 1, 2019, with the additional judge or chancellor to be appointed by the governor; authorizes the voters of the 23rd judicial district to elect the additional judge or chancellor at the August 2020 general election to serve until September 1, 2022. - Amends TCA Title 8; Title 16; Title 17 and Title 18.

**[HB 1467](#) by \*Daniel (SB 1329 by \*Watson)**

Administrative Procedure (UAPA) - As introduced, requires state agencies to submit an estimate of total compliance and implementation costs on the effects administrative rules and regulations have on small businesses within this state to the members of the joint government operations committees prior to filing the rule. - Amends TCA Title 4, Chapter 5.

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Education Discussion

**[HB 0224](#) by \*Parkinson (SB 0070 by \*Robinson)**

Education, State Board of - As introduced, increases, from one to three, the minimum number of board members who must be employed, at the time of the appointment, as a K-12 public school teacher, beginning with appointments made on or after January 1, 2020. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 1.

**[HB 1402](#) by \*Hicks (SB 1339 by \*Johnson)**

Education, Dept. of - As introduced, requires the department and the comptroller of the treasury to conduct a study of the total amount of funds spent to build, equip, and maintain elementary and secondary schools; requires a comparison between the average instructional salary of teachers in this state and the average salary of teachers across the southeastern United States; requires a study of the amount of sales tax collections appropriated to K-12 education. - Amends TCA Title 49 and Title 67, Chapter 6.

Taxes - As introduced, clarifies the "Taxpayer Bill of Rights" provision requiring the department to keep confidential the financial information provided by a taxpayer. - Amends TCA Title 67.
