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**[HB 1637](#) by \*Lamberth (SB 1620 by \*Haile)**

Professions and Occupations - As introduced, revises provisions governing payment to persons selling scrap metal that consists of copper or an unattached catalytic converter; requires scrap metal dealers to keep possession of unattached catalytic converters and copper scrap metal for at least five days. - Amends TCA Title 62, Chapter 9.

Child Custody and Support - As introduced, allows the court to approve agreements pertaining to custody and residential parenting schedules without making further inquiry and an independent determination that the modification is in the best interest of the child, if the parties announce an agreement to the court on the record or execute a permanent parenting plan approved through entry of an agreed order. - Amends TCA Title 36, Chapter 4 and Title 36, Chapter 6.

**[HB 1563](#) by \*Staples (SB 1602 by \*Briggs)**

Children - As introduced, requires TACIR to conduct a study on factors affecting the financial burden on relative caregivers caused by the opioid crisis, along with other issues pertaining to relative caregivers, and provide a report with findings and any recommendations to the general assembly no later than January 1, 2021. - Amends TCA Title 37.

**[HB 1634](#) by \*Littleton (SB 1627 by \*Stevens)**

Human Services, Dept. of - As introduced, transfers from the comptroller of the treasury to the department the duty to study, determine, and review the actual costs of clerks of court providing services for which federal financial participation is available for child and spousal support cases under the Title IV-D child support program; requires the department to report the cost information to the comptroller and the department of finance and administration on a biennial basis. - Amends TCA Title 36, Chapter 5, Part 1.

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**[HB 1571](#) by \*Moon (SB 1630 by \*Swann)**

County Government - As introduced, authorizes a county mayor to appoint a committee to approve amendments to the budget after the budget has been adopted under the Local Option Budgeting Law of 1993. - Amends TCA Title 5, Chapter 12, Part 2.

**[HB 1597](#) by \*Moon (SB 1632 by \*Swann)**

County Officers - As introduced, authorizes county legislative body to pass a resolution to pay county commissioners a salary plus an amount for attendance at meetings of the body and other ad hoc committee meetings; prohibits increases in county commissioner compensation taking effect during the term in which the increase was adopted. - Amends TCA Section 5-5-107.

**[HB 1570](#) by \*Moon (SB 1631 by \*Swann)**

County Government - As introduced, extends the period in which a vote of a county commissioner having a conflict of interest can be challenged; requires county mayor to call a special meeting if the challenged vote would change the outcome of the vote. - Amends TCA Section 5-5-112.

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**[HB 0134](#) by \*Love (SB 0088 by \*Akbari, Kyle)**

Expunction - As introduced, decreases from five to three years the amount of time from the completion of a person's sentence that must have elapsed before the person may apply for expunction of records. - Amends TCA Title 40, Chapter 32, Part 1.

**[HB 1348](#) by \*Miller (SB 0827 by \*Akbari, Gilmore, Yarbro)**

Expunction - As introduced, clarifies that a person seeking expunction of multiple offenses must petition the court in which the most recent conviction occurred; requires the clerk to serve the petition on the district attorney general for that judicial district and any other judicial district in which the person was convicted of an offense sought to be expunged. - Amends TCA Title 40, Chapter 32.

Consumer Protection - As introduced, prohibits a person who regularly engages in or solicits consumer transactions involving the installation of used tires from installing an unsafe used tire on a motor vehicle; specifies that installing an unsafe used tire is a violation of the Tennessee Consumer Protection Act of 1977. - Amends TCA Title 47 and Title 55.

Criminal Offenses - As introduced, repeals the County Bounty Act. - Amends TCA Title 38, Chapter 11, Part 2.

**[HB 1186](#) by \*Chism (SB 0656 by \*Robinson)**

Criminal Offenses - As introduced, revises the penalties for theft of property. - Amends TCA Title 39 and Section 40-32-101.

**[HB 0881](#) by \*Dixie, Chism (SB 0677 by \*Gilmore)**

Criminal Procedure - As introduced, enacts the "Drug Treatment Instead of Incarceration Act." - Amends TCA Title 16; Title 33 and Title 40, Chapter 20.

**[HB 0883](#) by \*Dixie, Chism (SB 0686 by \*Akbari)**

Criminal Procedure - As introduced, allows certain felony offenders to petition to have the offender's criminal history records sealed after completion of all requirements of sentencing and at least five years without being convicted of a new offense. - Amends TCA Title 39 and Title 40.

**[HB 1545](#) by \*Staples, Hakeem, Hardaway, Chism, Parkinson, Lamar**

Public Health - As introduced, directs the Tennessee Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental Relations to study the homicide rate of African-American victims in this state to determine the causes of the state's high rate, whether legislative action is necessary to address those causes, and ways in which the state and local governments can work together to reduce the rate; requires TACIR to make its report to the general assembly by January 31, 2021. - Amends TCA Title 38 and Title 39.

**[HB 1608](#) by \*Staples (SB 1601 by \*Briggs)**

Elder Abuse - As introduced, enacts the "Safe Seniors Act of 2020." - Amends TCA Title 39; Title 40 and Title 71.

**HB 1471 by \*Hardaway (SB 1322 by \*Kyle)**

Law Enforcement - As introduced, requires each local law enforcement agency to enter into an agreement with the Tennessee bureau of investigation to require the TBI to investigate any officer-involved shooting that occurs within the jurisdiction of the law enforcement agency. - Amends TCA Title 8, Chapter 6; Title 8, Chapter 7 and Title 38.

**HB 1475 by \*Hardaway (SB 1321 by \*Kyle)**

Law Enforcement - As introduced, creates Class E felony of law enforcement officer operating a law enforcement body camera in any manner that would prevent the creation of evidence with the intent to obstruct justice. - Amends TCA Title 10 and Title 39.

**HB 1478 by \*Hardaway (SB 1315 by \*Kyle)**

Criminal Offenses - As introduced, revises certain reckless endangerment provisions; establishes enhanced punishment for certain acts of reckless endangerment; establishes enhanced punishment for acts constituting "community terrorism." - Amends TCA Title 39, Chapter 13 and Title 40, Chapter 35.

Education, Dept. of - As introduced, allows an LEA to choose to administer TCAP tests to its students in a paper format beginning with the 2020-2021 school year if the commissioner authorizes TCAP tests to be administered in a computerized format; requires the department to provide TCAP test materials in a paper format to LEAs choosing to administer TCAP tests in a paper format. - Amends TCA Title 49 and Chapter 475 of the Public Acts of 2019.

**[HB 1559](#) by \*Zachary (SB 1604 by \*Briggs)**

Education, Curriculum - As introduced, requires each LEA and public charter school to provide age-appropriate instruction to public school students in kindergarten through grade 12 on the events of September 11, 2001, annually on September 11. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 6.

General Assembly, Statement of Intent or Position - Urges the State of Tennessee to evaluate the Classical Learning Test (CLT) for State-sponsored scholarships and admission to public universities. -

**[HB 1561](#) by \*Zachary (SB 1641 by \*Massey)**

Education, Higher - As introduced, prohibits a public institution of higher education from requiring a student to submit a high school transcript or GED certificate as part of the institution's admission process if the student has completed an associate degree at a regionally accredited institution. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 7.
