Air Pollution - As introduced, requires the department of environment and conservation to develop a plan to implement the federal affordable clean energy rule and submit the plan to the EPA for approval by June 15, 2020. - Amends TCA Title 7; Title 65; Title 68 and Chapter 478 of the Public Acts of 2015.

Landlord and Tenant - As introduced, reduces the statutorily required notice period for termination of residential tenancy to three days in a county with a population more than 75,000 and to 14 days for all other counties in situations where an unauthorized subtenant refuses to vacate the premises. - Amends TCA Title 66.

Utilities, Utility Districts - As introduced, clarifies definition of utility district commissioner for purposes of continuing education requirements; revises other related provisions. - Amends TCA Section 7-82-308; Section 7-82-709; Section 68-221-1305; Section 68-221-605; Section 68-221-1009 and Section 68-221-1206.

Sunset Laws - As introduced, extends the department of finance and administration to June 30, 2024; requires the department to appear before the government operations committee by June 30, 2020, to update the committee on the department's progress in addressing audit report findings relating to records disposition authorizations. - Amends TCA Title 4, Chapter 29 and Title 4, Chapter 3.

Administrative Procedure (UAPA) - As introduced, requires state agencies to hold rulemaking hearings when promulgating proposed administrative rules that may affect a person's rights. - Amends TCA Title 4, Chapter 5, Part 2.

Criminal Offenses - As introduced, requires a court to order a person who commits evading arrest and, in doing so, damages government property to pay restitution to the appropriate government agency for the damaged property. - Amends TCA Section 39-14-408 and Title 39, Chapter 16, Part 6.

[HB 1557](#) by *Zachary (SB 1606 by *Briggs)

Litter Control - As introduced, increases from a Class C misdemeanor to a Class B misdemeanor the penalty for committing mitigated criminal littering if the litter is or includes human waste in a container. - Amends TCA Title 39, Chapter 14, Part 5.

[HB 1667](#) by *Hodges, Curcio, Griffey (SB 1582 by *Powers)

Juvenile Offenders - As introduced, allows a juvenile court judge to require a juvenile less than 14 years of age at the time an act was committed to register as a violent juvenile sexual offender if the juvenile is adjudicated delinquent for certain acts that, if committed by an adult, would constitute certain violent sexual offenses; requires a hearing and consideration of certain factors. - Amends TCA Title 37, Chapter 1, Part 1; Title 39, Chapter 13 and Title 40, Chapter 39, Part 2.

[HB 1805](#) by *Lamberth, Garrett, Weaver, Marsh, Whitson, Griffey, Russell (SB 1783 by *Haile)

Criminal Offenses - As introduced, enacts the "Spencer Bristol Act," which increases the penalty for evading arrest that results in the serious bodily injury of a law enforcement officer to a Class C felony and evading arrest that results in the death of a law enforcement officer to a Class A felony. - Amends TCA Title 39, Chapter 16, Part 6.

HB 1569 by *Howell (SB 1763 by *Bell)

Professions and Occupations - As introduced, allows written waivers, exculpatory agreements, or releases executed by whitewater rafting professionals to be kept in electronic format. - Amends TCA Title 70, Chapter 7, Part 2.

HB 1850 by *Carter (SB 1817 by *Gardenhire)

Law Enforcement - As introduced, requires the conduct of law enforcement personnel in initiating or continuing pursuit of a fleeing party to be in reckless disregard of law enforcement policies and procedures in order for the law enforcement personnel or the employer of the law enforcement personnel to be liable for injuries to a third party proximately caused by a fleeing party. - Amends TCA Title 55, Chapter 8.

HB 1676 by *Carter (SB 1769 by *Haile)

Adoption - As introduced, clarifies the role of a guardian ad litem in a contract for post adoption contact; makes various changes to adoption, including clarifying the meaning of certain terms. - Amends TCA Title 36, Chapter 1, Part 1 and Title 37, Chapter 2, Part 4.

HB 1802 by *Farmer, Ogles, Griffey (SB 2000 by *Bell)

Sexual Offenses - As introduced, adds administration of a controlled substance or narcotic drug to a victim without the victim's consent or knowledge for the purpose of incapacitating the victim to the circumstances under which a rape becomes an aggravated rape. - Amends TCA Title 39, Chapter 13, Part 5.

HB 1663 by *Farmer (SB 1980 by *Stevens)

Victims' Rights - As introduced, adds Tennessee residency as a requirement for participation in the crime victim address confidentiality program; creates a cancellation exception for a program participant if the secretary of state determines the participant is residing at a shelter; decreases from 60 days to 20 days the period of time a program participant must be found to be unreachable prior to the cancellation of a program participant's certification; makes other revisions to the program. - Amends TCA Title 40, Chapter 38, Part 6.

Criminal Offenses - As introduced, adds imminent danger of serious sexual abuse as a justification for the use of deadly force in self-defense and to defenses of duress and use of deadly force by law enforcement officer; defines serious sexual abuse as rape, aggravated rape, rape of a child, or aggravated rape of a child. - Amends TCA Title 39 and Title 40.

Probation and Parole - As introduced, requires the board of parole to create an application that a victim may use to submit a victim impact statement video to be considered at an inmate's parole hearing and at any future parole hearing involving the same inmate and offense. - Amends TCA Title 40.

Criminal Offenses - As introduced, repeals the County Bounty Act. - Amends TCA Title 38, Chapter 11, Part 2.

Criminal Offenses - As introduced, revises certain reckless endangerment provisions; establishes enhanced punishment for certain acts of reckless endangerment; establishes enhanced punishment for acts constituting "community terrorism." - Amends TCA Title 39, Chapter 13 and Title 40, Chapter 35.

Tennessee Housing Development Agency - As introduced, increases, from \$2.93 billion to \$5 billion, the maximum aggregate principal amount for which the agency may issue bonds and notes at any one time. - Amends TCA Section 13-23-121.

Taxes, Real Property - As introduced, makes various revisions to the property tax appeal process. - Amends TCA Title 67, Chapter 5.

Meigs County - Subject to local approval, extends occupancy period required for a person to be considered a transient for purposes of the hotel occupancy tax from not less than 90 days to not less than 200 days. - Amends Chapter 23 of the Private Acts of 2001.

Holidays and Days of Special Observance - As introduced, designates the month of April as "Health and Beauty Month." - Amends TCA Title 15, Chapter 2.

Secretary of State - As introduced, extends from March 1 until March 8 each year, the date by which the secretary of state must transmit to the house of representatives the omnibus list of qualifying applicants to conduct a charitable gaming event in this state; permits rather than requires the secretary of state to develop application and other forms required to obtain approval to conduct a charitable gaming event in this state. - Amends TCA Title 3, Chapter 17.

Traffic Safety - As introduced, authorizes Sumner County and municipalities within the county to establish special speed limits in school zones. - Amends TCA Section 55-8-152.

[HB 1620](#) by *Lamberth, Garrett, Weaver, Ragan, Moon, Reedy, Travis, Crawford, Griffey, Casada, Russell (SB 1613 by *Haile, Yager)

Driver Licenses - As introduced, adds documentation a veteran may submit to the department of safety to have military service indicated on a driver license to allow an honorably discharged veteran to submit a certified copy of the veteran's AGO Form 53-55 or NAVPERS 553 showing the dates of service. - Amends TCA Title 55, Chapter 50, Part 3.

Traffic Safety - As introduced, extends the "Slow Poke Law," which prohibits the operation of vehicles in the left lane, except for passing and other purposes, to interstates and multilane divided highways with two or more lanes. - Amends TCA Title 55, Chapter 8, Part 2.

[HB 1614](#) by *Hulsey (SB 1749 by *Lundberg)

Motor Vehicles, Titling and Registration - As introduced, authorizes issuance of special purpose boat dealer plates to manufacturers and dealers who hire operators of boat trailers to transport boats to customers. - Amends TCA Title 55, Chapter 4.

[HB 1682](#) by *Haston, Griffey (SB 1734 by *Hensley, Niceley)

Highways, Roads and Bridges - As introduced, authorizes county legislative bodies to adopt alternative procedures for the opening and changing of public roads in the county, in addition to the closing of such roads; authorizes formation of a committee of the county legislative body to perform certain functions for the opening, changing, or closing of such roads if no regional planning commission exists. - Amends TCA Title 54, Chapter 10, Part 2.

Motor Vehicles, Titling and Registration - As introduced, authorizes, upon request, the department of revenue to issue salvage certificates to an insurance company or a salvage pool operator under certain circumstances. - Amends TCA Title 55.

[HB 1596](#) by *Howell, Jernigan, Moody, Powell (SB 1612 by *Massey, Dickerson)

Transportation, Dept. of - As introduced, requires the department to create the office for accessible transportation within the department to provide resources and expertise for expanding and improving accessible transportation in the state. - Amends TCA Title 4, Chapter 3, Part 23; Title 54 and Title 55.
