FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 737 - SB 1241

February 18, 2019

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Authorizes the State Board of Education (SBE) to extend the six-year period required for the standards review and development committees and advisory teams to review the standards for English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies for a period not to exceed three years.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

Other Fiscal Impacts – To the extent the State Board of Education extends the review period, Board expenditures may shift from one year to another year; the precise amounts and timing of any such shifts cannot be reasonably determined. The SBE currently receives recurring state funds of \$106,700 for the standards review process.

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (004349): Deletes and replaces all language after the enacting clause such that the only substantive change is to remove science and social studies from the standards reviews that may be delayed.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- The SBE currently receives recurring state funds of \$106,700 for the standards review process.
- Passage of this legislation will not impact total funding for the standards review process; however, there could be delays when some portions of the funding is expended by the SBE. The precise amount and timing of any such impact cannot be reasonably determined.
