FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 794 - SB 1082

March 4, 2019

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Authorizes any establishment, which is currently authorized to sell wine and high alcohol content beer for consumption on its premises, to also serve wine or high alcohol content beer.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (005152): Requires that the alcohol awareness training required of applicants for a server permit be at least three and one-half hours in length.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT: Deletes all language after the enacting clause.

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- Requiring alcohol awareness training be at least 3.5 hours in length will have no significant impact on state or local government.
