FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 699 - SB 997

March 5, 2019

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Establishes the Tennessee Plane Coordinate System (TPCS) as the system of defining and stating geographic positions and locations in Tennessee. Requires the TPCS be recognized and utilized as the sole system after December 31, 2022.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (005270): Deletes and rewrites all language after the enacting clause of the original bill without making any substantive changes to the legislation.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- The most recent system of plane coordinates established by the United States Department of Commerce, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's National Geodetic Survey, based on the National Spatial Reference System, is the State Plane Coordinate System.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 66-6-101, the Tennessee Coordinate System of 1983 is recognized and utilized, which was established by the same organization.
- Any additional workload to the Department of Transportation in transitioning to the TPCS as the sole system of defining and stating geographical positions and locations after December 31, 2022, can be accomplished with current resources and personnel; therefore, there will not be a significant impact on state expenditures.
