FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 219 - SB 923

**SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL:** Defines terms related to gasification and pyrolysis for the purpose of the Tennessee Solid Waste Disposal Act. Excludes gasification and pyrolysis from the definition of solid waste processing.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

**SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (006271):** Deletes and rewrites all language after the enacting clause such that the only substantive changes is to further clarify the definitions related to gasification and pyrolysis and to establish that unless the context requires otherwise or if the proposed legislation defines otherwise, the definitions set forth in Tenn. Code Ann. §68-211-103 and 68-211-802 and in any rules promulgated pursuant to this chapter, apply to terms used in this proposed legislation.

**FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:**

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- Based on information provided by the Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC), excluding gasification and pyrolysis from the definition of solid waste processing will not result in a significant impact on permit fee revenue to TDEC.
- The proposed legislation will not significantly impact TDEC's current processes and procedures. Therefore, any impact on TDEC's expenditures will be not significant.
