FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 1416 - SB 1219

March 20, 2019

**SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL:** Authorizes persons housed in emergency management agency camps or shelters to possess personal items and portable electronic devices, including mobile telephones and laptop or tablet computers.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

**SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (006310):** Deletes all language after the enacting clause. Authorizes persons housed in emergency management agency camps or shelters to possess a mobile telephone.

**FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:**

**Unchanged from the original fiscal note.**

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- Authorizing persons being housed in a camp or shelter organized or maintained by an emergency management agency, or pursuant to an action taken by such agency, to possess a mobile telephone will not result in a significant fiscal impact to state or local government.
