FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 179 – HB 416

March 23, 2019

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Requires a minimum 12-month wait period, following the tenure of service on a board of trustees of a hospital authority, before a trustee or former trustee is authorized to enter into an arrangement for employment or the provision of labor or services with the authority.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (006428): Deletes all language after the enacting clause such that the only substantive change is to require a hospital authority to publish on its website and in a newspaper of general circulation in the county in which the hospital authority is located, any arrangement for employment or the provision of labor or services, between a trustee or former trustee and the authority, within three business days of finalizing the arrangements. Requires arrangements existing as of July 1, 2019 be published by August 1, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- Hospital authorities will publish any arrangement for employment or the provision of labor or services between a trustee or former trustee and the authority utilizing existing resources.
- The proposed legislation will not have a significant impact on the procedures or processes of the Department of Health; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
