FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 365 - SB 389

March 25, 2019

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Requires a county election commission to appoint a minimum number of election officials at least 20 days prior to an election, rather than at least 10 days prior to an election.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (006513): Deletes all language after the enacting clause. Clarifies that a county election commission is to be considered a county entity, and that employees of a county election commission are employees of the county. Further clarifies that the exercise of an administrator of election's duties, jurisdiction, and authority is limited to the respective county and that the duties of such administrator may be performed by a designee.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- Based on information provided by the Division of Elections, this legislation simply clarifies existing statute and the current status regarding county election commissions, their employees and elected officials.
