FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 431 - HB 1021

March 25, 2019

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Extends, from 90 to 120 days, the deadline after a revision for a county to file updated maps of county districts with the county clerk, Comptroller of the Treasury (COT), and Secretary of State (SOS).

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (006397): Deletes all language after the enacting clause. Prohibits local governments from regulating, prohibiting, or assessing a fee regarding the use, disposition, and sale of certain containers, foods, and drinks beyond what is required by state regulation.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- According to the Department of Environment and Conservation, the Department of Agriculture, the Department of Health, and local sources, no local government has currently enacted any such regulations or fees; therefore, any fiscal impact to state or local government is estimated to be not significant.
