SB 452 - HB 513

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Increases, from once a year to every six months, the frequency the Board of Judicial Conduct is required to review its formal records retention policy.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (008342): Deletes all language after the enacting clause. Reconstitutes the Board of Judicial Conduct (Board). Revises various provisions regarding the Board.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-29-239(a)(43), the Tennessee Board of Judicial Conduct terminated June 30, 2018.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-29-112, upon the termination of any governmental entity, it shall continue in existence until June 30 of the next succeeding calendar year for the purpose of winding up its affairs.
- According to the Administrative Office of the Courts, the Board's expenditures were \$258,337 in FY16-17 and \$244,362 in FY17-18.
