FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 1392 - SB 1244

April 16, 2019

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Changes, from the beginning of every school year to September 1 of each year, the deadline for nonpublic schools to provide parents and guardians information about the meningococcal and influenza diseases and the effectiveness of vaccination against the diseases.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (008148): Deletes all language after the enacting clause and rewrites the bill such that the only substantive change is to specify that a non-public school is not prohibited from operating as a Category II non-public school if the school meets requirements established by the Department of Education (DOE) and the State Board of Education (SBE).

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- No impact on the public school system.
- No significant impact to DOE or SBE.
- No significant impact to state or local operations.
- No change to Basic Education Program (BEP) funding.
