FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HJR 732

**SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL:** Urges the United States Drug Enforcement Administration to reclassify marijuana as a Schedule II drug under the Controlled Substances Act. Resolves that certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to the appropriate individuals.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

**SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (015629):** Deletes all language after the enacting clause. Urges the United States Drug Enforcement Administration to reclassify marijuana as a drug under the Controlled Substances Act to ensure that marijuana is available for medically controlled use and research, for patients who benefit from medical marijuana, and for evidence-based scientific research to be conducted to determine the benefits and harms of marijuana for various medical conditions. Resolves that certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to the appropriate individuals.

**FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:**
