FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 1587 - HB 1601

March 3, 2020

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Requires the Department of Revenue (DOR) to submit to the Fiscal Review Committee, the Senate Transportation and Safety Committee, and the House Transportation Committee a one-time report, on or before March 1, 2020, identifying the number of qualified motor vehicles that have been issued a sticker or decal for operating a vehicle in a high-occupancy vehicle (HOV) lane and the projected number of motor vehicles that may be issued a sticker or decal for each of the next four years.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (015860): Deletes all language after the enacting clause. Adds the NA Form 13038 (certification of military service) to the list of documents which a person may show to receive the indicator of veteran status on their driver's license.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- Accepting an additional form, in addition to the two that are currently permitted, for receiving the veteran status indicator on a driver's license is estimated to not increase license renewals or to create any significant changes in workload for the Department of Safety and Homeland Security; therefore, any fiscal impact is considered not significant.
