FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 2091 - HB 2885

March 9, 2020

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Designates September 14 of each year as “Star-Spangled Banner Day”.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (016261): Deletes and replaces language in the original bill such that the only substantive change to the legislation removes the requirement of the Governor to proclaim September 14 as “Star-Spangled Banner Day.”

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- The proposed legislation does not declare a legal holiday as defined in Tenn. Code Ann. § 15-1-101; therefore, the fiscal impact to state or local government is estimated to be not significant.
